The June 1973 Cattle Chart presents, as mentioned in the commentary, a simplified version of CCTS trading of the cattle markets. The complexity of trading is amply illustrated by this list of complete and actual trades made in the cattle markets. You will see contrary to the simplified presentation of the cattle

chart, that in actual trading other option months were chosen ahead of June until March of 1973. From these lists of trades one may also see the continuous processes of limiting losses and letting profits run. Notice how many losing trades were necessary in order to realize the large profit trades.

Second Edition Note: In our opinion, the illustrative nature of this example is as valid in 1976 as it was in 1973. Nonetheless, post '73 cattle trades have been supplied for the Second Edition.
